**Notification of English Language Learner (ELL)  
Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs) Determination**

This “**Notification**” is to inform you that your student’s school district did not meet its Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs). This means that not enough students within the ELL program made adequate yearly progress to meet the objectives set forth by state and federal requirements.

The State has defined English language learner achievement targets that are used to evaluate the effectiveness of language instruction. Each school year, the State is provided with all of the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA) proficiency scores, which are analyzed to measure a program’s effectiveness. These scores, in addition to state assessment scores (AzMERIT and the NCSC Alternate Assessments) determine whether the district has met the AMAOs set forth by state and federal requirements.

**This letter is only meant to inform you of the district’s AMAO determination. The district will take the necessary measures needed for improvement.**
