

The NEW Entity Administration

This quick guide provides Entity Administrators in the MCESA Alliance with an overview of the new Entity Administration application and recommends which roles to assign to MCESA RDSS users.

What's new with Entity Administration for MCESA RDSS users?

You might notice that the new Entity Administration application 'looks and feels' like **RDSS**: **Profile**; this should make the transition easier for Entity Administrators in the MCESA Alliance. The new functionality available includes:

- Browser compatibility
- Real-time updates
- Bulk capability for editing role assignments

What's remains the same with Entity Administration?

As an Entity Administrator in the MCESA Alliance, you will use Entity Administration for:

- Managing those ADEConnect application roles not sourced from HQT
- Controlling user access for those ADEConnect application roles not sourced from HQT
- Maintaining information security by ensuring MCESA RDSS users only have access to the applications and data they are authorized to view and utilize.

Recommended RDSS Roles to Assign Using Entity Administration

Assign the RDSS roles below to those MCESA RDSS Users whose ADEConnect application roles are not sourced from HQT:

- Academic Coach
- RDSS District Administrator
- RDSS Former User
- RDSS Peer Evaluator
- RDSS Program Administrator
- RDSS Support Specialist

Recommended Roles to Assign Using HQT

Assign Educators the roles below in HQT because these roles will be translated into the appropriate ADEConnect application role which will grant users access to the RDSS applications:

- Teacher
- Vice-Principal
- Coach
- Principal
