Beginning April 1, 2016, the ESS EDP and Private School application will be available in ADEConnect.

Description

The ESS EDP and Private School program enables public schools and DHS-licensed private facilities to complete electronic applications to be recognized as one of three types of ADE-approved educational facilities for students with disabilities:

- Private Day School
- Residential Treatment Center
- Emotional Disability-Private

Each application is valid for one fiscal year.
