Subject: Military Families and Eligibility in the Child Nutrition Programs

This memorandum reiterates the policy used for households affected by deployments in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and possible future military contingencies.

Questions concerning household size often arise during times of military deployment. For the purpose of determining household size for any of the Child Nutrition Programs, deployed service members remain a resident family member living apart on a temporary basis. A school or an institution would instruct families to include the names and income of deployed service members on their meal benefit forms. The determining official would count the service member as part of the household in establishing a child's eligibility for free and reduced price meals.
