Arizona CCC Team Training will focus on College and Career Competencies identified through student needs assessments, teacher feedback, and evidence-based research, such as:

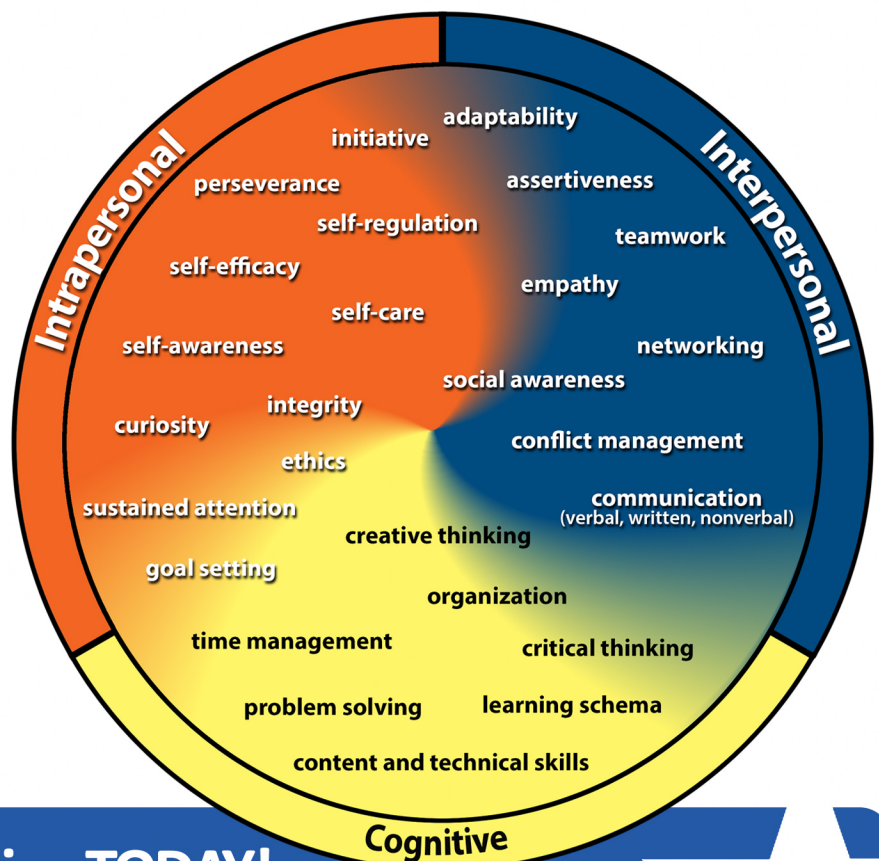
- Self-Efficacy • Self-Regulation
