PROMPT

The Phoenix Art Museum has a call for artwork. They are asking artists to respond to contemporary issues in society, i.e., homelessness, AIDS, terrorism, animal rights, sexism, etc. You have decided to submit a piece of artwork. An artist statement will be required and all artwork must be labeled and show-ready.

PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS

You will be scored based on the <u>Visual Arts Rubric for Accomplished Standards</u> that your teacher will provide for you.

- 1. You will need to demonstrate the following within your finished presentation:
 - Your choice of media, method, and technique.
 - Connections to contemporary issues in social, cultural, and political history.
 - Employed ethical standards including copyright, fair use, and appropriations.
 - Your knowledge, craftsmanship, and skills with purpose.
- 2. An artist statement must accompany your work. Your artist statement should connect your artwork to your chosen contemporary issue. (Refer to artist statement examples to guide your work.)
- 3. Annotated thumbnail sketch(es) are to be submitted with your artwork.
- 4. You are to choose how to exhibit your artwork, for example, mat, frame, stand or pedestal, and installation.
