

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
COMPUTER SCIENCE, PREK-12 ENDORSEMENT

ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – CERTIFICATION UNIT

➤ **Computer Science, PreK-12 Endorsement**

The endorsement shall be automatically renewed with the certificate on which it is posted.

Requirements for the Computer Science, PreK-12 endorsement are:

1. Completed [Application for Certification](#).
2. Appropriate fee (see *Application for Certification*).
3. A photocopy of your valid Arizona Department of Public Safety Identity Verified Prints (**IVP**) fingerprint card.
A valid Arizona Elementary, Secondary or Special Education certificate.
4. Option A or B.

A. Coursework and Subject Knowledge (All requirements A-1 through A-3 must be met.):

A-1. One course in the methods of teaching Computer Science at the elementary level.

A-2. One course in the methods of teaching Computer Science at the secondary level.

A-3. A minimum of 30 semester hours of courses in computer science content area, which may include the required methods of teaching the Computer Science courses.

B. Out-of-State Certificate or Endorsement:

B-1: The applicant holds a valid, comparable Computer Science PreK-12 certificate or endorsement from another state and is in good standing with that other state. Submit a photocopy of your out-of-state certificate or endorsement.
