

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE
DRIVER'S EDUCATION ENDORSEMENT
ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – CERTIFICATION UNIT

➤ **Driver's Education Endorsement**

The Driver's Education endorsement is optional. The endorsement shall be automatically renewed with the certificate on which it is posted.

Requirements for the Driver's Education endorsement are:

1. Completed [Application for Certification](#)
2. Appropriate fee (see Application for Certification)
3. A photocopy of your valid Arizona Department of Public Safety Identity Verified Prints (IVP) fingerprint card (plastic).
4. A valid Arizona Teaching certificate.
5. Option A or B.

A. Coursework and Qualifications. (All requirements A-1 through A-3 must be met.):

- A-1. A valid Arizona driver's license.
- A-2. A three semester hour course taken from an accredited institution or 45 clock hours of state approved classes in each of the following: safety education, driver and highway safety education, and driver education laboratory experience. Submit official transcripts or certificates of training.
- A-3. A driving record with less than seven violation points and no revocation or suspension of driver's license within the two years preceding application (available from Motor Vehicle Division).

B. Out-of-State Certificate or Endorsement

B-1: The applicant holds a valid, comparable Driver's Education certificate or endorsement from another state and is in good standing with that other state. Submit a photocopy of your Driver's Education certificate or endorsement.
