ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – CERTIFICATION UNIT

*The certificate is optional and issued to individuals to teach a Native American language in grades PreK-12.*

➤ **NATIVE AMERICAN LANGUAGE, PREK – 12 CERTIFICATE**

*The certificate is valid for twelve (12) years and may be renewed.*

**All requirements for the Certificate must be met:**

1. Completed [\*Application for Certification\*](#).
2. Appropriate fee (See *Application for Certification*)
3. A photocopy of your valid Arizona Department of Public Safety Identity Verified Prints (**IVP**) fingerprint card. For more information visit <http://www.azed.gov/educator-certification/fingerprint-clearance-card-ivp/> .
4. Language proficiency in a Native American Language. Proficiency shall be verified on official letterhead by a person(s) or entity designated by the appropriate tribe.
