This memorandum is to inform you that the State Board of Education has voted on the following items regarding the 2014 A-F Letter Grade Accountability System presented at the May 19th meeting:

- 1) New A-F Letter Grade Substantive Appeals process
- 2) Incorporate College and Career Ready Index (CCRI) graduation rate component only for all high schools in FY2014 which necessitates the following:
 - a. Maintain traditional high school letter grade scales
 - b. New alternative high schools model
 - c. Set alternative point scale for all alternative schools

This means that all traditional schools – high school and elementary – will defer to the 2013 point scale below in 2014 as well. High school and elementary alternative schools will use a set point scale based on the 2012 distribution scale. The CCRI Graduation component will compose 15% of the alternative high school letter grade.
