RE: **A.R.S. 15-232 Semiannual Report to the Arizona Legislature from
Adult Education Services: December 2, 2014 – June 19, 2015**

The Arizona Adult Education System was ranked 3rd nationally for educational gains, producing over two grade level increases for less than \$1,250 per student annually. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics show that adults who complete Adult Secondary Education and earn their high school diploma by passing the GED® Test earn \$9,412 more in taxable wages each year, which generates tax revenue at both the state and federal levels almost immediately.

Of the 10,123 people who applied for instruction in Arizona Adult Education during the reporting period, 453 people (4.5% percent) were denied instruction because they failed to provide acceptable evidence of citizenship or legal residence in the United States.

At the time of enrollment, ALL students must provide documented proof of legal residency. To ensure compliance with ARS 15-232 C., ADE staff conducts on-site inspections of student enrollment records annually.

The following table provides current and historical state totals for the number of people who are waitlisted for classes in each AES service area, who applied for classes, and who were denied enrollment in accordance with ARS 15-232 C.
