## Accountability A-F CCRI Self-Reporting Roles

### Description

The Accountability A-F CCRI Self-Reporting web application allows schools and districts to enter the CCRI Points Earned total displayed on the completed College and Career Ready Self Reporting Score Spreadsheet (A-F CCRI Self Report Spreadsheet.xlsx). Superintendents and principals are held accountable for the accuracy of the information entered via this application.

The web application will be available beginning **June 1, 2017**, and close on July 15, 2017, at 5:00 p.m.
