PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The **Carpentry** program is designed to prepare individuals to apply technical knowledge and skills in the building industry which include units of instruction in safety, hand and power tools, foundations, floor, wall, ceiling and roof framing, exterior and interior finishing including installation of cabinetry and flooring, and align with the NCCER core and Carpentry standards for a craft professional. The program is designed and delivered as a coherent sequence of experiences using technical instruction, academic foundations, experiential learning, work-based learning, and leadership and personal development through the Career and Technical Student Organization SkillsUSA. This program can lead toward an industry-recognized NCCER credential, OSHA 10 certification, and/or United Brotherhood of Carpenters (UBC) career connection certification or to Registered Apprenticeships.
