PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The **Hospitality Management** program is designed to prepare students for employment in positions that provide customer-focused services in such facilities as hotels, restaurants, resorts, spas, convention centers, National parks, travel agencies, and cruise lines. The **Hospitality Management** program incorporates the management, marketing, and operations of restaurants and other food services, lodging, attractions, recreations events, and travel-related facilities.

A student completing the **Hospitality Management** program will possess the knowledge and skills associated with reservations and front desk operations, meeting and banquet room support services, food and beverage support services, housekeeping, laundry operations, supervisory functions, and environmental functions. Students will develop advanced employability skills including critical and conceptual thinking, communications, applied academics, and technology. In addition, students will gain job skills that are necessary to enter the hospitality and commercial food service workplace successfully.

The **Hospitality Management** program can lead toward the following certifications: Certified Front Desk Representative, Certified Guest Service Professional (CGSP®), Certified Hospitality and Tourism Management Professional, Certified Restaurant Server, NAFTrack Certification, National ProStart Certificate of Achievement (COA), and/or ServSafe® Food Protection Manager.

The **Hospitality Management** program utilizes a delivery system made up of four integral parts: formal/technical instruction, experiential learning, supervised occupational experience, and the Career and Technical Student Organizations FCCLA and DECA.
