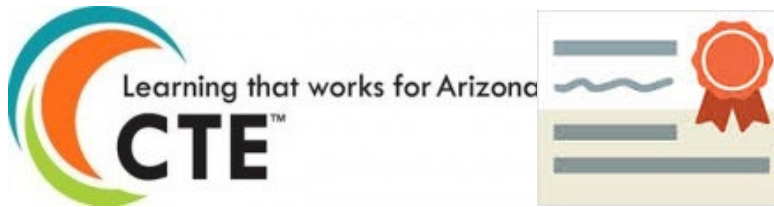

## PD Certification Credit

**Looking for CTE Professional Development Certification Credit to move from a Provisional to Standard Certificate?**

There is no charge to Pima County JTED employees or their member district

employees. For non-member employees or 'Public Interest' there is a \$100.00 charge per course if you are taking the course for ADE certification to move from a Provisional to Standard certificate or deficiencies in obtaining the Standard certificate. Our *Workshops* are free for all participants to earn certificates for ongoing professional development which count toward the specified 180 hours a Standard Certified Teacher needed every 12 years to renew their certificate.

### **Interested in submitting a PD activity for PD Certification Credit?**

#### **Professional Development for Teacher Certification Credit**

Professional Development approved for CTE Teacher Certification Credit can be used in lieu of semester hours. These Professional Development hours must be approved by the Arizona Department of Education / Career and Technical Education (ADE/CTE) in order to meet the semester hours requirement.

The Career and Technical Education K-12 Certification process allows for the required professional development to be obtained through staff / professional development activities offered by the local education agency, professional organizations, universities and community colleges.
