

## Arizona High Quality Teacher Professional Development Pilot Program Application

Arizona certified teachers are eligible to apply for a scholarship of \$2,000 to apply toward the cost of professional development at a regionally or nationally accredited public or private postsecondary educational institution in Arizona. The purpose of these scholarships is to support already certificated teachers in gaining additional credentials and/or certification in the areas of science, technology, engineering, math, or career and technical education to help with teacher shortages in these content areas. The scholarship is limited to 150 applicants, and will be awarded on a competitive basis. Scholarship recipients must agree to teach in an Arizona public school for a minimum of three years after completing the coursework or program.

TeacherProfessionalDevelopmentScholarship@azed.gov. Beginning July 31, 2017, applications will be reviewed within 10 days of receipt and awardees will be notified via email with directions on how to initiate the process of receiving the scholarship.
