CREATING STANDARDS

You are to create an original musical composition. Your composition will be based on music used in rehearsal. The original composition may be created or re-imagined. You will work with performers to revise your composition and submit your completed composition portfolio to your instructor.

Your **Composition Portfolio** should include A.) Your draft composition preserved in standard written notation B.) Your completed "**Composer's Rehearsal Notes, Self-Reflection and Revision Sheet**" C.) Your completed "**Composition Portfolio Check Sheet**" D.) Your final composition preserved in standard written notation.

You will be evaluated based on the <u>Music Ensemble Rubric for Novice Creating Standards</u>.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

TIME FRAME: 1-2 Weeks

- 1. Composers are to create/re-imagine at least two measures in length that reflect melodic, rhythmic and/or motives that demonstrate understanding of characteristic(s) of music or text(s) studied in rehearsal.
- 2. Composers are to utilize standard written notation to preserve their draft and final compositions and the "Composition Portfolio Check Sheet to make sure their work is complete throughout the project.
- 3. Composers are to share their work with a performer(s). The performer is to provide feedback on clarity of notation, criteria of characteristics to be included, and performance challenges that may arise during the performance of the composition.
- 4. Composers are to complete "Composer's Rehearsal Notes, Self-Reflection and Revision Sheet" based on the performer(s) feedback and revise their composition.
- 5. Composers will submit their completed "Composition Portfolio" to their instructor for evaluation. Another music instructor will also evaluate the Composition Portfolio.
