PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Federal Level Changes Required LEA Activities

BOTH NCLB AND ESSA

Provide language instruction educational programs (LIEPs) designed to increase the English language proficiency and academic achievement of ELs

Provide <u>effective</u> professional development to classroom teachers designed to increase the knowledge and skills of teachers who serve ELs

NEW TO ESSA

Provide and implement other <u>effective</u> activities and strategies that enhance or supplement LIEPs for ELs, which <u>shall include</u> parent, family, and community engagement activities

Parent Involvement Translation/Interpretation

No changes to federal laws regarding parent communication

Parent Involvement Translation/Interpretation

 Title III funds are allowed for translating:

 supplemental EL events that support specific Title III-funded activities

Title III funds are not allowed for translating:
required documents
information LEAs communicate to all parents
events including parents of non-EL students



Parent Involvement Translation/Interpretation Examples

NOT ALLOWABLE:

Handbook with district/school calendar, staff directory, district programs, EL program info, etc.

NOT ALLOWABLE:

Parent-Teacher Conferences

LE: Schoolwide Curriculum Nights, Meet the Teacher Night, etc.

ALLOWABLE:

EL Parent Night designed to teach instructional strategies to parents of ELs for home practice with ELs

All activities must still meet the supplement, not supplant provision.



Planning for Funding



State Level Changes Local Plan Requirements

SAME:

Each eligible entity desiring a subgrant shall submit a plan to the State educational agency

SAME:

LEA plans shall contain information which 1. describes its language instruction educational programs, 2. ensures it is assisting ELs to achieve English proficiency and meet challenging academic standards, 3. describes its intent to promote parental and community involvement in the education of English learners, and 4. identifies Title III funded programs/activities (Title III tag).

NEW: Plan information will be entered in the new Integrated Action Plan which will replace the Continuous Improvement Plan in ALEAT.

Where can I find this new ESSA information? SEC. 3116(a) PLAN REQUIRED.

Integrated Action Plan

Principles

 Identify the principle where a primary need, or a required grant activity, will be addressed

Strategies

 Create a strategy and desired outcome aligned to the Principle to address your primary need or required grant activity

Action Steps

- Identify activities in support of the created strategy to achieve the desired outcome
- Tag activities based on the funding source to be used to support the activities and/or program connection

ALEAT Tags

Funding Tags (Title III)

✓ Required

- Associated with grant programs participating in the IAP Pilot for FY18
- Have expenses accounted for in the grant application associated with that tag



Program Tags (ELL)

Optional

- ✓ Indicate how activities may impact different programs and/or student populations
- ✓ Are not necessarily associated with a specific funding source

34 CFR 76.708

When certain subgrantees may begin to obligate funds.


- (a) If the authorizing statute for a program requires a State to make subgrants on the basis of a formula (see §76.5), the State may not authorize an applicant for a subgrant to obligate funds until the later of the following two dates:
 - (1) The date that the State may begin to obligate funds under §76.703; or
 - (2) <u>The date that the applicants submits its application to</u> <u>the State in substantially approvable form</u>.
