

EL Long Term Goal

Proposed Long Term Goal:

- ➤ Arizona will increase the percent of students making progress towards English language proficiency by 3% annually over 10 years, from 40% in 2017 to reach 70% making progress towards proficiency in 2028.
- > Time to Proficiency= 4 years



SEI Endorsement

Per State Board Rule- R7-2-615. Endorsements L. Structured English Immersion (SEI) Endorsements - Pre-K through 12

A Provisional or full Structured English Immersion (SEI) endorsement, or an English as a Second Language or Bilingual endorsement, shall be required of a teacher who is instructing students in a sheltered English immersion or structured English immersion model.



Appropriately Certified

Elementary SEI Teachers:

- > SEI, ESL, or BLE endorsement
- > Elementary Education certificate

Secondary SEI Teachers:

- > SEI, ESL, or BLE endorsement
- Middle Grades ELA or Secondary English certificate



Parent Withdrawal Forms

- **✓ MUST BE** parent initiated.
- ✓ **CANNOT** be part of enrollment process.
- ✓ Once a student is parent withdrawn, a new form is <u>not</u> required annually, <u>UNLESS</u> the student changes schools or districts, where services should be offered to parents.
- ✓ Annual program placement forms are <u>NOT</u> required for students who have been parent withdrawn.

ELP Standards

Arizona English Language Proficiency (ELP) Standards are being revised to align to the Arizona English Language Arts Standards (adopted in December 2016).

- > ELP Standards Review meetings begin in October, 2017.
