Each year ADE requests that you submit two ECAP documents. Please use the ALEAT system to upload the two documents into your **ALEAT 2020 ECAP Monitoring Instrument** by **March 6, 2020. The two documents are:**

- 1. A copy of the school-wide implementation action plan or calendar (action plans or calendars should include: What, Where, When, Who in order to present a clear picture of your ECAP process for ALL students).
 - * See the attached ECAP Accountability Rubric to help with your site assessment.
- 2. A copy of a completed ECAP Plan from <u>one</u> student from the graduation class of 2020 with all identifying student information removed in order to be FERPA compliant).

To ensure that ADE receives your submission, please use the attached ALEAT instructions to locate and select the "submit" button. Additionally, be sure to review any comments left in the "State Findings" ECAP 2018-19 box prior to submitting your 2020 documents.
