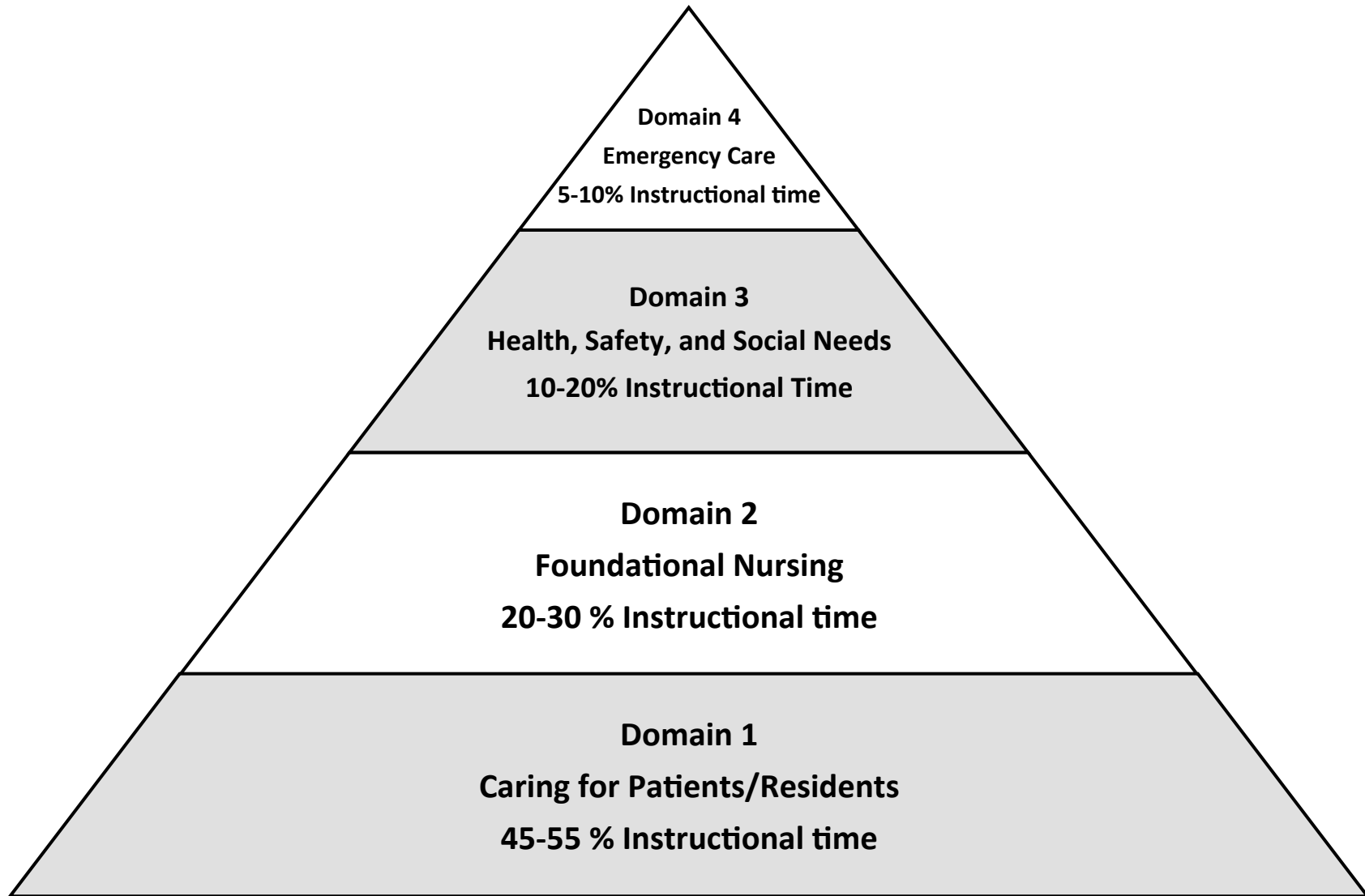


Content Domains
