Elementary, Secondary, or Special Education certificate with a Computer Science PreK-12 endorsement	Thirty (30) semester hours of coursework in Computer Science to include elementary methods and secondary methods of teaching Computer Science.	PreK-grade12 Computer Science
Subject Matter Expert Standard certificate in Computer Science	<u>One</u> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Experience teaching Computer Science courses at an accredited college or university for the past two consecutive years, and a total of three years; <u>or</u> A Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctoral degree in Computer Science; <u>or</u> Five years of relevant work experience in the field of Computer Science. 	Grades 6-12 Computer Science
Specialized Secondary STEM certificate in Computer Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Five years of work experience in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics; <u>and</u> <u>One</u> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Bachelor's or more advanced degree and 24 semester hours of coursework in Computer Science; <u>or</u> Experience teaching computer science courses at an accredited college or university for the past two consecutive years and a total of three years. 	Grades 6-12 Computer Science
