- R7-2-604.01 B-C Educator preparation programs (EPP) of professional preparation institutions (PPI) requesting Board approval shall be reviewed by the Department and the Department shall recommend Board action. Upon the recommendation of the Department, the Board shall evaluate and approve an EPP for a period not to exceed six years.
- New Professional Preparation Institutions (PPI) to Arizona will need to submit the readiness review documents 90 days prior to the submission date.
- Late submissions will be reviewed at the discretion of the Department. Late submissions do not change the expiration date of the program.
