











Instructional Calendar

AzEDS collects instructional calendars via the REST API to validate student data in Integrity.

Permissions

Entity Administrators manage ADEConnect permissions for their respective Local Education Agencies (LEAs). Permissions to the AzEDS Calendar feature allow a user to access the Calendar User Interface and to view and interact with calendar reports.

The Calendar reports menu appears among the other report menus:




The Calendar User Interface adds a new menu item to the AzEDS Portal Ribbon where the user can view calendars submitted by their LEA:



AzEDS Calendar User Interface

The AzEDS Calendar User Interface shows a user all the calendar tracks for their respective LEAs. The user interface allows a user to visualize the calendar, certify track(s), and view a list of uploaded changes to specific tracks since the last Integrity processing.



- Sort and Filter: The Calendar User Interface can be sorted or filtered on any of the headings.
- 2. Choosing the track opens the "View Calendar" screen with a visualization of the selected track.
- 3. With a viewer-level permission, the Certifed column displays the Certified status of each track.














- 4. **Integrity Radio Buttons:** Changes the displayed visualization between the track event descriptors available at the most recent AzEDS Integrity process and the track event descriptors submitted since the last AzEDS Integrity process.
- 5. **Track Header Information and summary:** Displays the track begin date, end date, and instructional days as submitted, and the summarized track event descriptors.
- 6. Legend of track event descriptors: The legend helps summarize and display track event descriptors.
- 7. **Pre-Integrity vs Post-Integrity Comparison list:** Choosing the next tab opens a list that compares the track event descriptors available from the most recent AzEDS Integrity process and the track event descriptors submitted since the last AzEDS Integrity process.















- 8. **Difference between last AzEDS Integrity process and real-time visualization:** The checkbox allows the user to filter for lines with changes to the track event descriptors.
- 9. List line turns red when a track event descriptor has changed since the list AzEDS Integrity process.



10. If a user has permission to Certify a track: The Certified column shows a button on tracks that are currently available to Certify. A **Certify button** opens a screen with a statement to validate.














11. The checkbox may be chosen whether certifying one or multiple calendar tracks.
