Leadership 200: Your Program; Your Data; Your Success

This 3-hour **team-based** regional workshop focuses on relationship building and aligning data to campus needs. Attendees must bring their FY18 grant application, Operational Plan, Logic Model, 2018-2019 school year incident data and school climate data (student/staff/parent survey) if available.

Who Attends? All of the following who were on the program in FY 2018 **AND** attended *Leadership 101: The Basics* **or** *Leadership 102: Beyond the Basics* in FY 2018 (SY17-18): The District/Charter Administrator, Site Administrator (Principal and/or Principal's Designee, if applicable) and the Agency Supervisor. Registering your team to include the SRO/JPO and school mental health/behavioral health person is considered a best practice for the content of this training and to support the integrity of the program.

FAQ: I am a District Administrator, Agency Supervisor or Site Administrator and was **not new** to the program last year, however, I did not attend *Leadership 102: Beyond the Basics*. What training do I attend this year? ANSWER – This year (FY19), you will attend two trainings: *Leadership 102 Webinar* AND *Leadership 200* with your team.

FAQ: As the school principal, I appointed a designee as the Site Administrator. Am I required to attend a training? ANSWER- You and your designee are required to have attended the *Leadership 101* training before the designee can attend subsequent trainings, such as *Leadership 200*, on behalf of the principal. If there is turnover in either position, the continuing administrator must ensure that the current year's training requirement is met; the **new** administrator must attend the Leadership training.

New Officer Training

This four-day workshop covers community oriented policing, the role of school-based officers, and an introduction to Law Related Education (LRE) as an essential prevention tool.

Who Attends? Officers **NEW** to the program in FY 2019 **OR** who joined the program in FY 2018 (SY17-18) but did not attend the *New Officer Training* in that year.

NOTE: Day 1 of *New Officer Training* is combined with *Leadership 101: The Basics*. It is recommended, that a new officer's District or Site Administrator register for L101 so they attend Day 1 together to ensure they are in accord with program philosophy and requirements.

FAQ: My district has an officer not funded by the School Safety Program grant. Can she/he attend the *New Officer Training*? **ANSWER-Yes!** Officers not on the grant are welcome to register for training on a pay basis and are waitlisted to ensure officers on the grant receive priority.

Who Attends? Continuing Officers-Upon completion of *New Officer Training*, officers are required to annually attend an *Advanced LRE Academy* through the AZ Foundation for Legal Services and Education.

FAQ: Can a teacher attend the Advanced LRE Academy? **ANSWER: YES!** Teachers may register and attend with the officer. A limited number of teacher scholarships are offered each year. Teachers create an account and register through the [Law For Kids](#) website.

Note: A teacher may be waitlisted to ensure officers on the grant receive priority.
