

Farm to Early Care Education The 2018 Farm Fresh Challenge

During the month of October

This Farm to Early Care Education reference guide provides information about the Arizona Department of Education's (ADE) Farm Fresh Challenge taking place during the month of October 2018. On a mission to encourage fresh and healthy offerings in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), the ADE invites Sponsors of CACFP and the partners that support them to participate in a month of celebration by supporting Arizona's farmers, ranchers, dairymen and gardeners through experience and education. Farm Fresh activities support three main objectives:

- 1. To serve more Arizona grown and raised products at meals served through the CACFP.
- 2. To encourage school garden celebrations in a fall garden, offer Garden to Café Programming as a component for CACFP or provide nutrition related activities that correlate to Arizona's vast seasonality.
- 3. To encourage educational activities related to Arizona's agriculture industry like taste testing local products, taking field trips to local farms or farmers markets, Meet the Farmer day, garden-based learning activities, or educational lessons focused on local food and agriculture. You may use one of ADE's resources such as *Harvest of the Season* or use one of your own marketing materials.

Celebrate the Farm Fresh Challenge

ADE will recognize all CACFP sponsors that complete the challenge and submit the registration form via Survey Monkey by September 28, 2018. Taste Arizona

Serve, at minimum, one local meal component (e.g., grain, dairy, fresh fruits or vegetables, eggs, or meat) during the month of October to encourage your community to eat Arizona grown, fresh and healthy

Teach Arizona

Host, at minimum, one educational activity during the month October. Educational activities that teach children about Arizona's rich agriculture scene and vast produce availability.

Connect Arizona

Share a minimum of one social media post on Facebook, Instagram or post to your website about your Farm Fresh Celebration(s). using the Hashtag #AZf2S, #AZf2ECE #farmtoschool

Every site that participates will be recognized at the Annual CACFP Renewal Summit scheduled for Summer 2019. *Three sites* will be selected to receive a *Best of the Bunch Award*, reflecting the elevation in meals served and educational opportunities provided, encouraging children to experience Arizona agriculture.
