ESS Annual Data (Requires secondary approval, access is not immediate)
 LEA Signer role (Reserved for school SPED Directors, Superintendents, CEOs, Business

 LEA User role (Anyone can request if SPED Director approves)
AzSAFE (Requires secondary approval, access is not immediate)
 Read role (Anyone can request if SPED Director approves)
