LEA Budget Changes aka Application Revisions

- FY 2019 Final allocations to be announced late September
- FY 2018 Completion Report approvals may generate additional funds

Being prepared for this additional funding will help ensure a more efficient and successful fiscal and programmatic application revision review process. Our role is to assist LEAs to have a compliant program, and set the LEAs up for success, in the event they are fiscally monitored or audited.









1. Understand the Purpose of Funding

Title III funds are allocated by the Federal government to help states, school districts/charters, and school sites provide effective services that improve the English language proficiency and academic achievement of English learners and immigrant children and youth.









2. Allocate Funds for the Required Activities

Title III funds MUST be used to provide:

- <u>supplemental language instruction educational programs</u> to increase the language proficiency of English learners,
- <u>effective professional development</u> to classroom teachers and EL staff designed to improve instruction and assessment of English learners, and
- <u>supplemental parent, family, and community engagement activities</u> that enhance language instruction educational programs for English learners.









3. Understand Supplement, Not Supplant

- Title III, Part A SEC 3115 (g)
 - SUPPLEMENT, NOT SUPPLANT.—Federal funds made available under this subpart shall be used so as to supplement the level of Federal, State, and local public funds that, in the absence of such availability, would have been expended for programs for English learners and immigrant children and youth and in no case to supplant such Federal, State, and local public funds.









Supplement vs. Supplant

Supplemental

- "Above and beyond" not "more of the same"
- "In addition to" and "not to replace"
- Situation specific for each LEA

Supplanting exists if funds are used to:

- provide programs/services which are provided to all students
- meet requirements for identification and assessment of English learners
- provide programs/services required by other Federal, State, and local laws
- provide programs/services previously funded with other funds









4. Consider Other Laws

Equal Educational Opportunities Act (EEOA), Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Title I, and Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.)

- All the above laws have requirements for activities LEAs are <u>obligated to provide</u> to English learners, parents of English learners, and parents who speak a language other than English.
- Title III funds CANNOT be used to fund services, activities and activities required under other laws.
- Title III funds must support <u>students</u> with a language need, not parents with a language need.









5. Verify the Coding

The USFR (Uniform System of Financial Reporting) Chart of Accounts provides a standardized account code structure for education monies used by public school districts and charters.

6. Provide Sufficient Information

- Narratives in GME or IAP must provide confirmation of supplement, not supplant
- For parent engagement activities, remember they are for parents of ELs not EL parents
- Narrative in GME should contain fiscal/quantitative information vs. narrative in IAP should fully describe the program/service
 - Check accuracy of fiscal information

Using amounts provided by the LEA, the actual amount is higher than what is requested. OELAS will request clarification on this item to ensure it has not been underfunded.









7. Identify the changes on revisions

- OELAS recommends leaving the initial approved grant narrative intact
- Call attention to budget revisions so they are easily identifiable
- Budget revisions must be reflected in IAP narratives, if needed










8. Fear Not the Calculator



- Math calculations are critical at all times, and especially during revisions
- Real time example: Table Activity










Can You Find the Three Errors?



Narrative total: \$1380 + \$864 + \$529 = \$2773

Line item total: \$2819









9. Check for Alignment

GME Grant narratives MUST match IAP descriptions! Double check:

- Position titles
- Numbers of days or teachers or items
- Date range of action step

Collaboration between IAP person and GME person is critical.









10. Use Appropriate IAP Tags

• <u>Funding Tags</u> have a direct correlation to items requested for funding in the grant application

Tag names: Title III and FY19_TIII

 Program Tags identify activities which impact a program or specific student population but are not tied to a specific funding source
Tag name: ELL

Integrated Action Plans are a two-year plan – Don't remove FY18 tags!

Draw attention to fiscal year differences within continuing action steps












Table Group Grant Reviews

Assign roles:


- Scribe: Take notes based on group discussion of each sample grant and IAP narrative
- Time Keeper: Set cell phone timer to 3 minutes; notify group at end of time
- Reporter: Share out the group's findings at the end of each sample
- Review GME grant narratives and IAP action steps
 - Table groups will review Sample #1 for fiscal errors, and GME and IAP misalignment
- Whole group discussion of Sample #1
- Reassign roles and repeat for remaining samples

















