Subject: FY 2019 Title III Final Allocation

This is formal notification of your Local Educational Agency's (LEA's) final allocation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 under Title III. LEAs that receive a Title III allocation amount of less than \$10,000.00 must join a consortium in order to receive these funds. The United States Department of Education requires States to hold consortia, like all other eligible LEAs, accountable under Title III. In Arizona, members of a consortium are treated as separate entities for accountability purposes, and if applicable, determinations are applied separately to each member of the consortium.

Title III funds must be expended to supplement the LEA's current EL program, to provide effective professional development for EL staff, and to engage parents and families of ELs in activities which enhance the EL program. LEAs must submit their Integrated Action Plan (IAP) in the Arizona Local Education Agency Tracker (ALEAT) prior to grant submission. Information regarding Title III required activities and IAP requirements can be found below and are also included in detail in the Title III Program Assurances in the Program Details section of the funding application in the Grants Management Enterprise (GME) System.

Please note that the distribution of final allocations into GME will create the need for LEAs to revise their FY 2019 Title III budgets and Integrated Action Plans (IAPs) accordingly. Revisions should be submitted in a timely manner to ensure all available funding has been included in the grant application.

Title III Funding Requirements

LEAs applying for Title III funds must spend grant funds to -

- increase the English language proficiency of English learners [Title III, Section 3115 (c) (1)]
- provide effective professional development to EL staff [Title III, Section 3115 (c) (2)]
- provide parent, family, and community engagement activities which enhance and supplement the EL program [Title III, Section 3115 (c) (3)]

Integrated Action Plan (IAP) Requirements

Arizona Local Education Agency Tracker (ALEAT)

LEAs applying for Title III funds must submit a plan, known as the Integrated Action Plan, to the Arizona Department of Education which identifies how the LEA will use these funds to support its language instruction programs for English learners. Prior to the LEA's Title III funding application being approved, the Integrated Action Plan (IAP) must be submitted in ALEAT.

Each plan submitted shall -

- describe the effective programs and activities that will help English learners increase their English language proficiency and meet the challenging State academic standards;
- describe how the eligible entity will ensure its schools will assist English learners in achieving English proficiency and meet challenging State academic standards;
- describe how the eligible entity will promote parent, family, and community engagement in the education of English learners.

Note: All programs, services and materials funded with Title III funds **must** be identified in action steps and tagged with the Title III tag. Programs and services supporting an LEA's EL program but **not** funded with Title III funds should be tagged with the EL tag.

Strategies and action steps may be positioned under any principle; however, placement should be based on the LEA's needs assessment results.
