- experience and expertise with working with communities to forge meaningful partnerships that foster commitment to improving the lives of youth and their families
- relevant experience and expertise in an education-related field
- experience and expertise with conducting evaluations of education programs or community programs for at-risk youth
- experience as a grant reviewer (preferably in education)
