Program Description, Industry Credential, Coherent Sequence, and Teacher Certification

### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The **Medical Assisting Services** program includes instruction in basic anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, medical law and ethics, patient psychology and communications, medical office procedures, and clinical diagnostic, examination, testing, and treatment procedures. The **Medical Assisting Services** program also prepares students to provide medical office administrative services and perform clinical duties including patient intake and care, routine diagnostic and recording procedures, pre-examination and examination assistance, and the administration of medications and first aid.

The **Medical Assisting Services** program is designed and delivered as a coherent sequence of school-based and work-based supervised learning. The Professional Skills developed by business and industry leaders across Arizona are integrated throughout the program. The **Medical Assisting Services** students develop leadership, social, civic, and career skills through participation in the Career and Technical Student Organization HOSA (Future Health Professionals).

The **Medical Assisting Services** instructional program prepares students for entry-level employment, further training, and/or post-secondary education for these and other occupations: Medical Assistant, Medical Scribe, Patient Care Technician, and Clinical Medical Assistant
