

Directions for the Accordion Fold

Accordion books truly have endless possibilities both in design and content. They are fun and easy to make. Here are only a few suggestions on variations for this book format.

Accordion books can vary by:

- Shape (square, rectangle, heart)
- Size (you can even make tiny accordion books into necklaces)
- Cover (paper choices such as wrapping paper)
- Closures (ribbons, buttons, etc.)
- Number of pages

Uses for the accordion book:

- Photo albums and memoirs
- Poems
- Favorite sayings
- Cards (birthday, graduation, congratulatory, retirement)
- Cartoon Strips & graphic books
- Stories (fiction and non-fiction)
- Retelling
- Sequencing
- Facts (math, science)
- Scientific Method

You can make the accordion book using two pieces of card stock or thin cardboard for the covers and a long piece of paper folded accordion style. Below are directions on how to fold the paper for an accordion book.

You'll need:

- 1. Paper (use thicker paper such as construction paper)
- 2. Scissors
- 3. Glue (glue sticks work well)

Directions:

- 1. Cut paper into strips lengthwise to make long rectangles.
- 2. Fold one strip in half.
- 3. Take one end and fold it back to the center fold.
- 4. Flip over. Take the other end and fold it back to the center fold.
- 5. Your paper will now look like the letter "M."
- 6. Repeat this step with another strip of paper.
- 7. Glue together the end flaps of each strip.
- 8. Keep going depending on how long you would like to make your accordion book.
