Monitor Progress: Although <u>a minimum participation rate is not required</u>, the higher the amount of participation, the greater the likelihood the data will be representative of your agency's population.

- 1. Log onto <u>ADEConnect</u> and select **ESS Data Surveys**. To obtain access to the application, please contact your <u>Entity Administrator</u>.
- 2. Choose the **Reports** tab on the welcome page.






✓ View Report format:

Page 1 displays PEA level results NOTE: The participation percentage is an estimate.



Page 3 and subsequent pages track survey status—completed/not completed surveys—by student name and school site. NOTE: Student lists were generated from the Census Application, October 1st FED SPED data and don't include new students. The lists may contain students who are no longer receiving services and new students can't be added.

Boost participation!

- ✓ Train teachers about the survey purpose and procedures. Emphasize the importance of parental input and involvement to impact student achievement. NOTE: Students do not take the survey.
- ✓ Post the survey description and link on district and school websites along with instructions on how parents can obtain a login code. Personalize your website or link to www.azed.gov/specialeducation/parents/parent-survey.
- ✓ Use email, social media, and message apps to promote the survey and send periodic reminders. Highlight the importance of parental input and involvement to impact student achievement. Mention that it will take only a few minutes to complete the survey!
- ✓ Offer use of a school computer or tablet when families are on campus for parent/teacher conferences, IEP meetings, school events, pick-up and drop-off times, parent group meetings, and home visits. Have translators or support staff available to assist parents.
- ✓ Partner with school-based and community groups to promote the survey.
- ✓ Activate and sustain high-impact family engagement programs throughout the school year to strengthen and maintain positive parent involvement.
