### SIG Cohort 4 Year 4 Application

Complete all sections in GME and upload required documents no later than close of business May 1, 2019

- This is a *competitive grant, give* detailed, complete answers
- Be sure to use the rubric to guide your narrative answers
- In order to be eligible for funding a minimum of 70% on the scoring rubric is required



#### The Application – a four step process

**<u>Step 1</u>**: Ensure all ALEAT requirements are completed, uploaded, submitted, and current.

**<u>Step 2.</u>**: Complete the all required sections in GME.

**Step 3:** Create a detailed proposed budget.

**<u>Step 4</u>**: Upload supporting documents into the Related Documents section.



#### Proposed Budget

- Complete a *proposed* budget in GME. Be sure to include sufficient details in the narrative
- Items must be aligned to your IAP and reflect evidence based strategies. Upload your evidence based worksheet into the Related Documents to support your proposed budget.
- Be sure that the requests for funds are reasonable and allowable
- Remember these funds are supplemental
- Ensure correct function and object codes and math is correct.







#### **Allowable Expenses**

- Data driven decision-making process
- Strategies and action steps based on CNA data analysis
- Strategies and action steps directly related to elements in selected Federal Model and IAP
  - Professional Learning activities (including conferences and related travel)
  - Educational Service Provider (external provider) services based on specific needs identified in CNA
  - Supplies directly related to implementation of model and/or IAP
  - Capital outlay items necessary to implement model and/or IAP
  - Position salaries necessary to implement model and/or IAP
  - Off contract pay for work such as planning committees, researching evidence-based interventions or curricula, conducting or attending professional learning or implementation of an intervention
  - directly connected to planning or implementation of an intervention for school year 2019-2020.
    - Board approved hourly rate paid, must be reasonable
    - Requires time and effort logs


