COMPREHENSIVE SUPPORT AND IMPROVEMENT GRANT PURPOSE

The purpose of the Comprehensive Support and Improvement Grant is to provide funding for CSI schools to implement the School Integrated Action Plan (IAP) strategies and action steps.





ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Federal Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI)
 Schools
 - Identification for low achievement (beginning 2017)
 - 2017 and 2018 state designated "F" schools.

Grant awards will not be made to
Local Education Agencies (LEAs)
that are out of compliance with state or
federal requirements, fiscal or programmatic.





IMPORTANT NOTES

- This is a competitive grant
- Complete a detailed application
- Include all required elements and documentation
- Application is scored using the scoring rubric
- 70% of points is required for funding







ALLOWABLE USE OF FUNDS

Items requested in the budget must address identified root causes leading to improved achievement

- Data driven decision making processes
- Leadership development
- Professional learning activities and related travel costs
- Supplies directly related to the action steps
- Off contract pay for work such as planning committees, researching evidence-based interventions or curricula, conducting or attending professional learning or implementation of an intervention
 - Board approved hourly rate paid
 - Requires time and effort logs









- Performance or incentive pay
- Miscellaneous or general office supplies
- Student rewards/incentives
- Out of state travel and large expenditures for capital items are generally not allowed.





DURATION OF GRANT



- CSI grants are awarded each fiscal year from July I (if director approved) through September 30th.
- CSI schools must re-apply for CSI funds each school year

May 1, 2019 FY20 Grant Application Closes

June 15, 2019 LEA Award Notification

July 1, 2019 Awards Available in GME

PROPOSED BUDGET



- Complete a proposed budget in GME.
 - Be sure to include sufficient details in the narrative.
- Items must address identified root causes leading to improved student achievement
- Be sure that the requests for funds are allowable.
 - Work with you specialist on what is allowable.





ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the FY20 CSI Grant the following must be completed and aligned to grant application.

- New 2019-20 CNA uploaded in ALEAT
- Thorough root cause analyses (fishbones) uploaded in ALEAT
- Completed 2019-20 LEA and School IAP in ALEAT including School Improvement required goals and tagged CSI









- Confirm the LEA and School Integrated Action Plans include all the strategies and actions steps for school improvement and are tagged CSI
- Ensure the proposed budget is closely aligned to the CNA, root causes, strategies and actions steps
