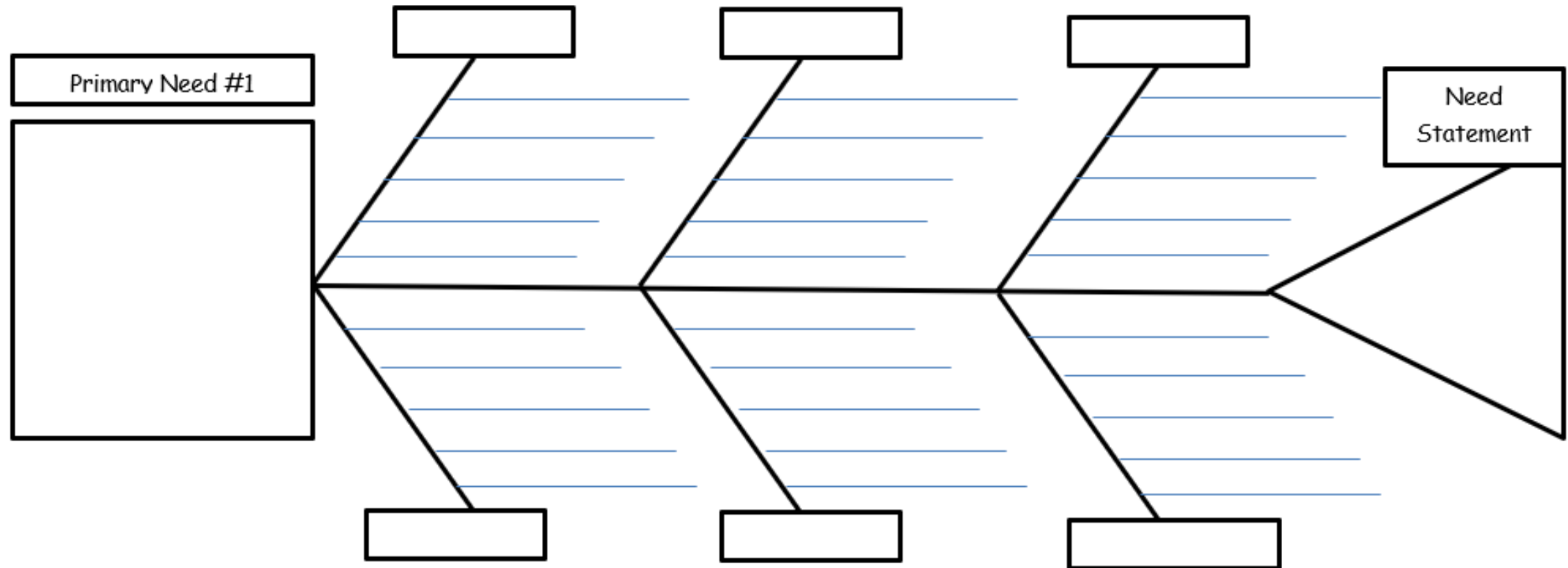
Comprehensive Needs Assessment
