TEACHER INPUT APPLICATION (TIA)

Online application to collect data on administrative/teaching positions and Educator Evaluation results

- All Title I public school districts must enter data each year
 - LEAs and schools update the database throughout the year
- Teacher position data is utilized to determine whether teachers meet the certification criteria for the positions they hold
- Data from the TIA is utilized by ADE to populate email distribution for agency emails
- Data from the TIA is utilized by ADE to sync teacher, student, course, etc. information in AzEDS

 - Appropriately certified
 - Shortage in the area of the position
 - Criteria for retention stipends
 - Appropriately certified
 - Demonstrated success with students
 - Returns the following year
