

Title I: Specific Areas of Concern



Set-Asides

- Clearly Label the set-aside in budget narrative
 - Example: Homeless Set Aside 7a Instructional Supplies (notebooks, pens, pencils
- Cross check calculation of funds in budget narrative with the set-aside page <u>especially</u> during a revision

Budget

- Coding Use USFR for <u>District Schools</u> and <u>Charters</u>
- Label school allocations.
 - Example: Arizona Elementary Reading Interventionist (1.0 fte) = \$45,000
 - School budgeted items should align with PPA List section
- Connector Verbiage IAP to GME
 - IAP strategies and action steps should contain the details of the plan. Budget should align to the plan (General Statements)

Eligibility Page

- If school is under federal accountability, please label as Comprehensive, Target or Both
- Revision: Enrollment & Low-Income Student Numbers cannot change from original approved application;
 Federal funding is based on previous year 40th or 100th day count

Top Five Problems With Title II-A Grant Approvability

- Specificity in the narratives
- Coding errors
- Allowable expenses
- Private Schools
- Recruitment and Retention







Specificity for Stipends, Conferences, Travel in the narrative of the grant

- Please include specific details, for example: the rationale for the stipend, number of teachers x the amount per stipend = total
- Please include specific details, for example: the name of conference, location, number of administrators x the registration costs = total
- Please identify the professional learning opportunities that are being funded. "PD for Teachers" is not specific enough to describe the activity

Title III: Application Submission Data

377 status changes to SEA Specialist Returned Not Approved

Return frequency: 1 to 8 times

0 grant applications approvable upon first submission

Average number of days to be approved: 89





Top Five Problems With Title III LEP Approvability


• IAP issues: 937 instances

Coding errors: 244 instances

Supplement, not Supplant: 162 instances

• Compliance: 154 instances

Math errors: 67 instances







Supplement Not Supplant is KEY to a compliant Title III grant!

- Provide detailed and specific information to confirm compliance with SNS
 - SNS for Title III is different than other Title funds
- Ensure collaboration between LEA programs to identify all activities provided at the LEA level
 - Other funds impact allowability with Title III
- Have knowledge and understanding of requirements of other laws (SEI Models, Title I, Title VI, EEOA)


