To qualify for a scholarship, applicants must be a(n):

- ✓ Arizona resident
- ✓ Youth/Young adult **between the ages of 14 and 26 years** with a documented disability
- ✓ Family member of a student with a disability or a personal assistant to a youth/young adult attending the conference

Special Notes:

- Scholarships cover registration, lodging, and mileage (upon request, for applicants who live 40 miles or more from the JW Marriott).
- Scholarship recipients are responsible for cost of food not provided by the conference.
- To ensure that scholarship funding is fairly distributed, the number of scholarships offered per family may be limited.
- If requests for scholarships exceed available funding, applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
