Complete the certification process through an onsite ACI Workshop or be evaluated via video submission online. In both cases, a candidate is assessed on instructional skills and the ability to deliver lessons. To be eligible for the ACI program, a candidate must: Pass the current Autodesk Professional Certification exam. Have at least one-year experience teaching. Clearly understand the content framework in the Industry Standards documents of ACI.
