Integrated SEI Instruction

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Integrated Instruction incorporates ELP Standards from multiple language domains into a cohesive lesson connecting language skills and academic content.

Elementary Option 1

Option 1: ELD instruction using the English Language Proficiency (ELP) Standards during two "blocks", totaling 120 minutes.

- Block 1: 60 minutes of integrated reading, listening & speaking, and vocabulary
- Block 2: 60 minutes of integrated writing and grammar



Secondary PE/E/B Option 1

Option 1: ELD instruction using the English Language Proficiency (ELP) Standards during two "blocks", totaling 100 minutes.

- Block 1: 50 minutes of integrated reading, listening & speaking, and vocabulary
- Block 2: 50 minutes of *integrated* writing and grammar



Planning Integrated Instruction

- 1. Plan for a balance of Reading, Listening & Speaking, and Vocabulary Performance Indicators.
- 2. Plan for rich and varied language experiences that incorporates content topics.
- 3. Plan for and facilitate academic discourse using academic vocabulary.

Integration Example: Socratic Seminar

- A teaching strategy to encourage students to engage in critical thinking, listening, and communication.
- Students participate in classroom discussion and teachers serve as facilitators.



Socratic Seminar Response Stems

Sample response stems:

- I think...
- I noticed...
- I agree with _____ because...
- I disagree with _____ because...
- What do you mean by _____...
- What I heard you say was ____...
- Could you explain that more?
- Could you give me an example?





Integrated Instruction - Option 1 Block 2



III-L-1(Q) HI-16: producing interrogative sentence beginning with "How"

III-L-1(Q)HI-15: producing interrogative sentences beginning with "Why"

III-W-HI-3: taking notes using self selected formats based upon knowledge of oral or written text structures with instructional support.



Integration Example: Expert Writing

Students take the role of an expert for a given topic, concept or unit of study.

- Students brainstorm (individually or with partners) questions someone would ask an expert relating to their area of expertise.
 - Sentence Formula: Why + What?
 - Why were the states fighting?

ASK AN EXPERT





Expert Writing

- During a unit of study, or individual lesson, the students generate notes about the answers to the those questions.
- The student writes an explanation or description of the topic or concept including all of his or her expert knowledge.

Focused Instruction includes the use of specific language methodologies to directly teach language domains; i.e. grammar and vocabulary.




