### How did FIRSTNA perform on the English Language Learner Assessment?

#### OVERALL PROFICIENCY LEVEL

- Proficient students consistently understand social and academic English and can generate sentences, using a variety of grammatical structures. They read, comprehend, and summarize information in grade-level text. These students write three- to five-sentence paragraphs, using grade-level vocabulary and a variety of sentence structures. Student is not eligible for ELL services.
- Intermediate students have a moderate understanding of social and academic English and can respond using a variety of simple sentences. They comprehend key details and main ideas of text read aloud to them. They have limited ability to decode and comprehend text read independently. They use basic vocabulary to write simple sentences.
- Student is eligible for ELL services.
- ✓ Basic students have a limited understanding of social
  and academic English and can respond using isolated
  words and simple phrases. They inconsistently
  comprehend key details and main ideas of text red
  aloud. These students have minimal ability to
  independently decode and comprehend text. they have
  minimal ability to write words, phrases, or simple
  sentences.
  - Student is eligible for ELL services
- Pre-Emergent / Emergent students have an extremely limited and inconsistent understanding of social and academic English. With instructional/environmental support, these students can formulate simple phrases and sentences orally and in writing. Student is eligible for ELL services.

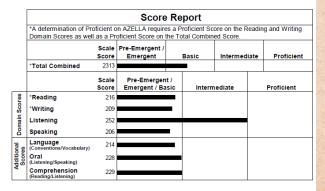

## **Test Records by CYCLE**

- Close of Cycle
  - Tests Cycle out of PAN and sent to ADE
- Electronic Results Date
  - PEARSON Published (PDF) Reports and Student Data Files available in PAN for this Cycle
  - First available date in which a student with test record from this Cycle can pass integrity
- Records with student demographic errors in the Corrections application
  - On or shortly after the Electronic results date
  - These records will NOT pass integrity until corrected
- Test Records on EL70, EL72, and EL73 (if OPL is less than proficient) Reports
  - Within one week following the Electronics results date
  - After records from Corrections application are corrected

  - (all others who require access to EL reports)

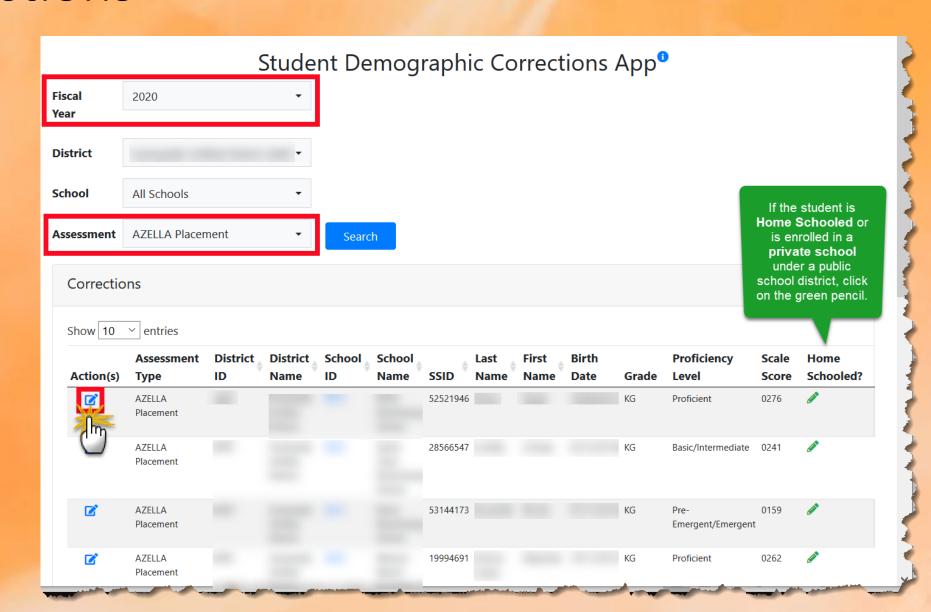


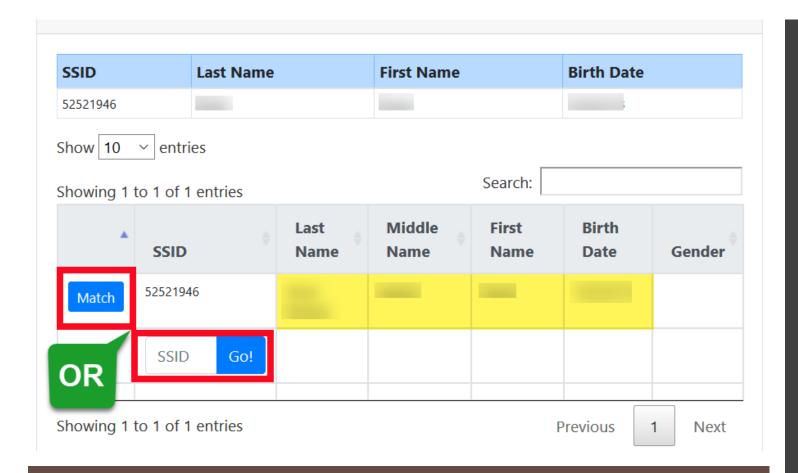


## **AZELLA Corrections**

- districts are not receiving EL funds for these students.



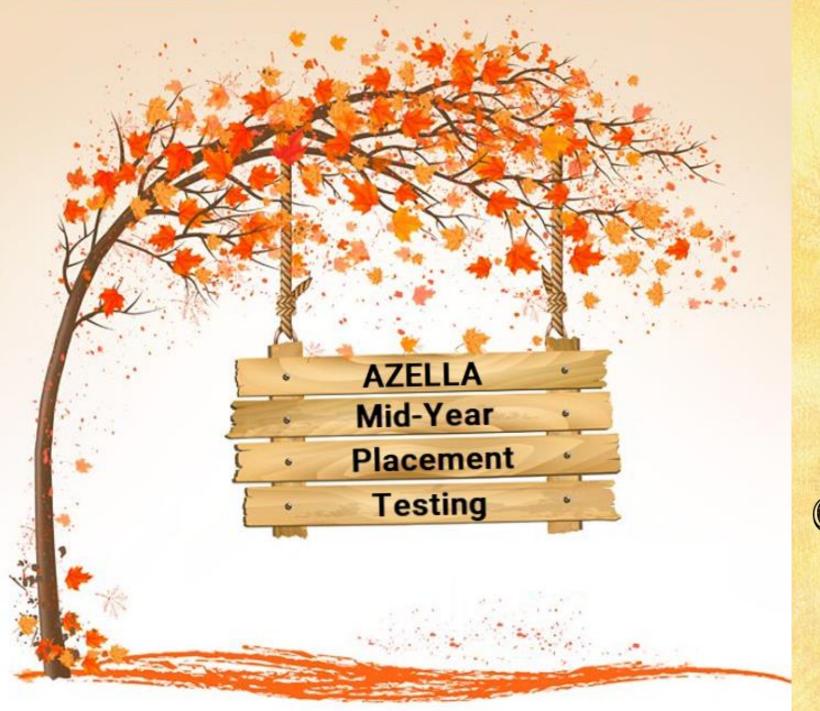

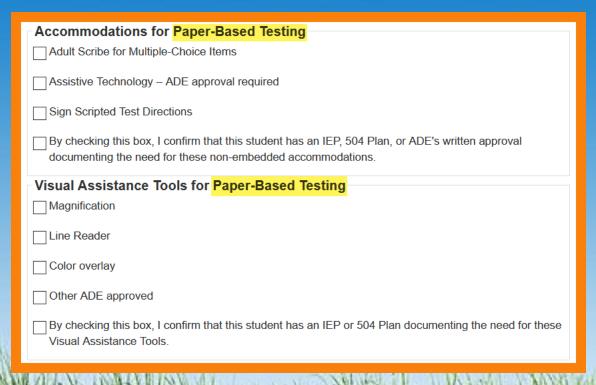

# Spring 2020 Reassessment Student Data

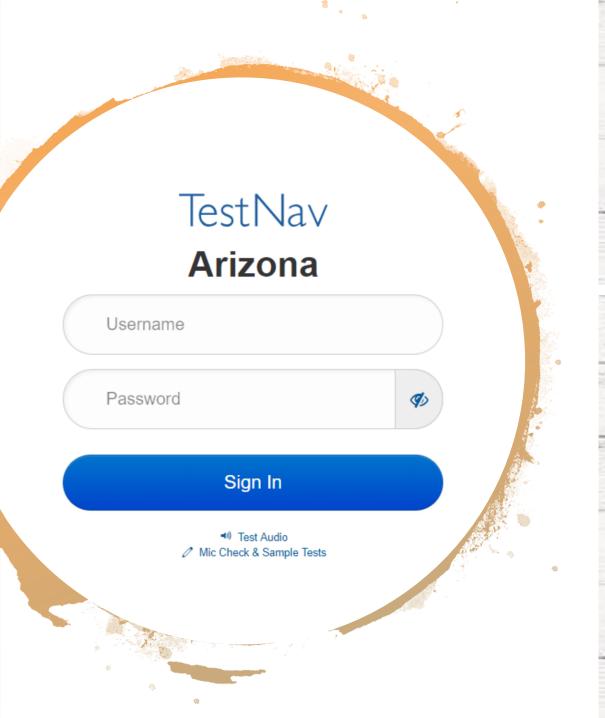
- ADE will be extracting student level data on 1/09/2020 (from the district's EL73 – EL Student Need Report)

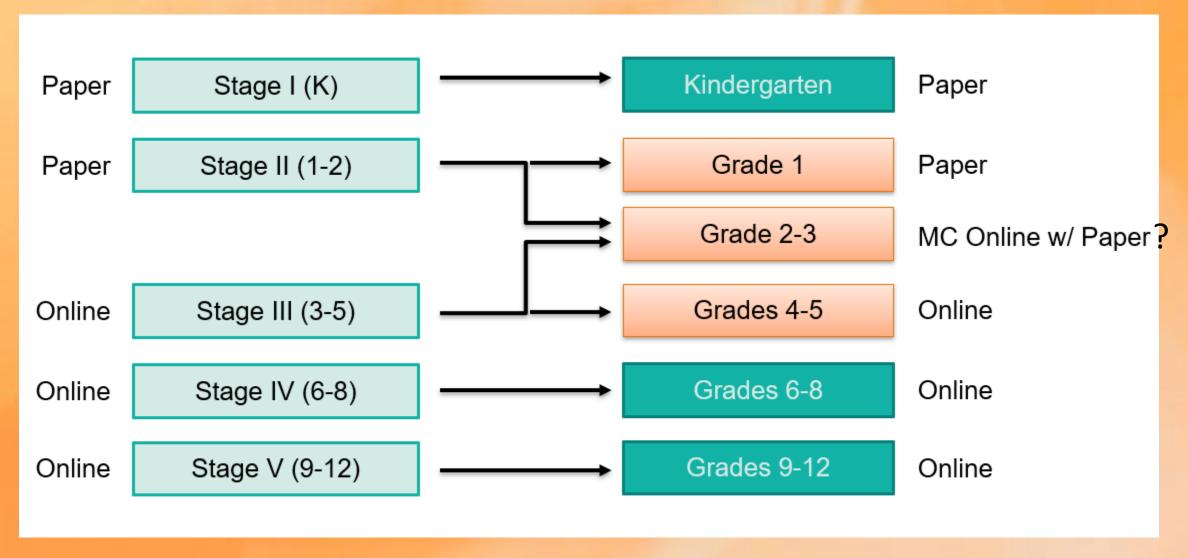








## 2010-to-2019 Standards Grade Alignment
