# Intent and Purpose of Title I-D

- ▶ Improve educational services for these children so they have the opportunity to meet challenging State academic content and achievement standards;
- ▶ Provide them with services to successfully transition from institutionalization to further schooling or employment; and
- ▶ Prevent youth who are at-risk from dropping out of school, and to provide dropouts and children and youth returning from correctional facilities with a support system to ensure their continued education.





# Definitions

- ▶ **Neglected Children** - When used with respect to a child, youth, refers to an individual who has been committed to an institution (other than a foster home) or voluntarily placed under applicable State law due to **abandonment, neglect, or death of his or her parents or guardians.**
- ▶ **Delinquent Children** - When used with respect to a child, youth, refers to an individual who resides in a public or private residential facility, other than a foster home, that is operated for the care of children and youth who have been **adjudicated, delinquent or in need of supervision.**





### DEFINITIONS

#### INSTITUTION FOR NEGLECTED CHILDREN

A public or private residential facility, other than a foster home, that is operated primarily for the care of children who have been committed to the institution or voluntarily placed in the institution under applicable State law, due to abandonment, neglect, or death of their parents or guardians.

#### INSTITUTION FOR DELINQUENT CHILDREN AND YOUTH

A public or private residential facility that is operated primarily for the care of children who have been adjudicated to be delinquent or in need of supervision. In this category also include local adult correctional institutions.

#### PART I IDENTIFY ELIGIBLE LOCAL INSTITUTIONS

In order to be eligible to be counted, a child age 5 through 17 must live in a locally operated facility that meets the definition of an institution for neglected children, an institution for delinquent children, or an adult correctional institution.
