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Non-Typical School Configurations

Schools that serve grades K-12, 1-12, 2-12, 3-12, 4-12, 6-11, etc. utilize both the K-8 and 9-12 models. Students in grades K-8 are used to determine the K-8 total points earned and students in grades 9-12 the 9-12 total points earned. The percentage of students in the A-F Static File in grades K-8 and 9-12 is used to weight the points to assign the school one overall percentage. To obtain one letter grade the following calculation is done:

$$\begin{aligned} & \textit{Non-Typical School Configuration Letter Grade} \\ & = \begin{bmatrix} \left(K - 8 \, Total \, Points * K - 8 \, student\% \right) \\ + \left(9 - 12 \, Total \, Points * 9 - 12 \, student\% \right) \\ \hline \left(K - 8 \, Total \, Points \, Eligible * K - 8 \, student\% \right) \\ + \left(9 - 12 \, Total \, Points \, Eligible * 9 - 12 \, student\% \right) \end{bmatrix} + \begin{pmatrix} \left(K - 8 \, Bonus \, Points * K - 8 \, student\% \right) \\ + \left(9 - 12 \, Bonus \, Points * 9 - 12 \, student\% \right) \end{pmatrix} \end{aligned}$$

Cut Scores

Non-Typical schools are assigned an A-F Letter Grade using the Traditional 9-12 cut scores (below).
