	Download the TestNav application on all devices to be used by students for the Spring 2020 AzSCI Prototype Field Test testing. Gather installation files from http://download.testnav.com/	Ongoing

Done	Task 2 – Verify Contact Information and Shipping Address	Dates
	Review and verify contact information and shipping address in PearsonAccess ^{next} (PAN). If contact information is incorrect, contact <u>AIMSScience@azed.gov</u> .	12/11/19 – 1/3/20
	Note: If you have multiple districts, you must verify each district separately.	

Verify Contact Information:

- Login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Organizations.
- Under Filters, select district name as the Parent Organization.
- Select Search. The district name will populate under Organization Name.
- At the organization's name, select the blue information icon ¹
- Select the **Contacts** tab and click on **AIMS District Test Coordinator** to view contact information.

Done	Task 3 – Create User Accounts in PearsonAccess ^{next}	Dates
	District Test Coordinators and/or School Test Coordinators may create user accounts for School Test Coordinators, School Test Administrators, and/or Technology Coordinators in PearsonAccess ^{next} .	Ongoing
	User accounts can be added manually or through an Import File.	
	Note : Users currently in PAN for AZELLA must also create an account for Arizona Science.	

NOTE: Only NEW users will receive an email notification to set up their new account in PearsonAccess^{next}. All others will just gain access to the Arizona Science test administration once the account is created for Arizona Science.

Create Arizona Science User Accounts Manually:

- Login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Users.
- Go to Start, select Create/Edit Users.
- Complete all required fields and select **Create** and **Exit Tasks.**

	Students will need to be added in PearsonAccess ^{next} .	1/6/20 - 2/21/20
	Students created manually must be registered and assigned a test.	(Prior to testing)
	Students can be added manually or through an Import File.	

Manually Creating Students in PAN:

Step 1 – Create

- Login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Students.
- Go to Start, select Create/Edit Students.
- Complete all required fields and select Create.

Step 2 – Register

- Select the **Register Students** tab. Under **Students**, select student name.
- Under **Details**, place a check next to **Registered** to activate the form.
- Complete form with the student's Grade or Cohort. Select **Save**.

Step 3 – Test Assignment

- Select the Manage Student Tests tab.
- Under the **TEST DETAILS** section, select the student's name from the dropdown.
- Under **Organization**, select the student's school.
- Under **Test**, select the correct test.
- Select the test **Type.** Select **Create.**

Creating Students in PAN using a Student Registration Import (SRI) File:

- Follow the directions to Review Student Demographic Information in PAN using the Student Registration Export as stated in the Spring 2020 AzSCI Prototype Field Test PearsonAccess^{next} User's Guide.
- To download the Student Registration Export or to download the blank Student Registration File Layout/Template, go to the **Support** or **Links** sections on the PAN Arizona Science home page.
- Fill in the Student Registration Import file according to the Data File Layout.
- Save the file as a .csv file.
- To import the file, login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Import/Export Data.
- From the Start drop-down, select All Tasks.
- From the **Type*** drop-down, select **Student Registration Import**.
- Select Choose File and select the Student Registration Import file created earlier.
- Select Process.
- Refer to directions provided in the Spring 2020 AzSCI Prototype Field Test PearsonAccess^{next} User's Guide.

Creating Testing Groups in PAN (Optional):

Arizona Science District Test Coordinators, School Test Coordinators, or Test Administrators wanting to group students by classroom or testing days, may do so by using the **Testing Groups** function.

- Login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Testing Groups.
- Go to Start, select All Tasks.
- Select the **Organization**, fill-in the **Name** and, if desired, type a **Description**. Select **Create**. Repeat this process until all groups are created.
- Select the Add/Remove Student Tests in Testing Groups tab.
- Select the **Testing Group** from the **TESTING GROUPS** list.
- To find the desired student, select the **Find by name or ID within the Organization** field to activate the dropdown. Scroll through the list or type in the student name or the student's SSID to find the student.
- Select the student name to add to the **Testing Group**. Repeat this until all students have been selected.
- Once the students are selected, they will populate below the **Find by** filter.
- Check the box for each student, select **Save**. Repeat this process for each Testing Group created.
- When all Testing Groups are created and populated, select Exit Tasks.
- Refer to directions provided in the Spring 2020 AzSCI Prototype Field Test PearsonAccess^{next} User's Guide.

Submitting Work Requests in PAN:

NOTE: When attempting to create a new student or add a transferred student in PAN and the student is already associated with another school or district, the District Test Coordinator (DTC) needs to submit a Work Request in PAN. This will request for the student to be transferred from one school/district to another school/district. If the work request has not been processed within 3-4 days, contact the ADE at <u>AIMSScience@azed.gov</u>.

- Login to PAN. From **SETUP**, select **Work Requests**.
- From the **Start** drop-down, select **All Tasks**.
- Select the Request/Delete Enrollment Transfer tab.
- Complete the information on the **New Enrollment Transfer** and select **Search**.
- Below the **Change Enrollment To*** field, enter the organization where the student needs to be transferred to.
- Select Send Request.
- After request has been sent successfully, select Exit Tasks.
- To confirm or view requests pending approval, use the filter status Waiting for Approval.
- The DTC from the releasing school district will receive an email notifying them of the work request.
- From the **Start** drop-down, select **Approve/Reject Enrollment Transfer**.
- Select one Enrollment Transfer request at a time. Select the Approve.
- If rejected, enter a reason in the Reject Enrollment Transfer Reason field, then select Reject.
- The DTC who submitted the original work request will receive an email indicating that the transfer request was approved or rejected.

	New Process for Special Paper Version (SPV) Test Requests	11/01/20 – 2/13/20
	All SPV test requests must be approved by ADE using the following steps:	, -, -
	 Step 1: Complete a request for a Special Paper Version Test for each student using the secure ADE online form. On this form, you must submit pages of the student's official IEP or 504 plan that indicate the need for a special paper version of the test. The document you submit must include: a. the date of the document and the student's First and Last Name and SSID. b. the section that indicates the student's testing accommodations. c. the section with classroom accommodations that are used routinely during instruction throughout the year in lieu of computer instruction. The instructional accommodations MUST align with the testing accommodations. 	
	Requests may be submitted November 1, 2019 – February 13, 2020 through the following link:

	• Special Paper Version test accommodations available for the AzSCI Prototype Field Test include Large Print and Regular Print Special Paper Version tests for grades 5, 8, and 11 and Braille for grade 11.	
	Step 2: After receiving approval from ADE, log into PearsonAccess ^{next} and indicate the Special Paper Version accommodation in the student's profile. Students with SPV tests must be moved to an SPV test session.	
	<i>Note:</i> Only the District Test Coordinator can create test sessions. SPV test sessions can be created beginning on January 6, 2020.	
	Step 3: Place the SPV order during the Additional Order window (See Task 6).	

Assigning an SPV Test to Student(s) in PAN:

Step 1 – Create an SPV Test Session

- Login to PAN. Under TESTING, select Sessions.
- Go to Start, select All Tasks.
- Under the Create/Edit Sessions tab, select Create Session.
- Select Session Name. Create one of the following test session names in all CAPS.
 - AzSCI GRADE 5 SPV
 - o AzSCI GRADE 8 SPV
 - AzSCI GRADE 11 SPV
- At **Organization** drop-down menu, select the school name.
- Select **Test Assigned**. Select the appropriate grade and test to be assigned to the test session.
- Enter Scheduled Start Date (no earlier than the first day of testing).
- At Form Group Type, select SPV Form.
- Select Create. Select Exit Tasks.

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Step 2 – Identify Students for SPV Accommodations

- Go to **SETUP**, select **Students**.
- Search for student by entering their SSID number or go to Search, select Show All Results.
- Check student(s) name that needs to be updated with an SPV accommodation.
- Go to **Start**, select **All Tasks**.
- At the **Manage Student Tests** tab and under **STUDENT TESTS**, select the assigned test identified under the student's name. **TEST DETAILS** will auto-populate for the student.
- Under Non-Embedded Accommodations, place a check mark in the box for any accommodations required by the student's IEP/504 Plan. Skip over the Visual Assistance Tools sections as they apply to computer-based testing only.
- Move down to the Order Special Paper Version (SPV) (with IEP or 504 plan) section.
- Only if applicable, select any additional testing accommodations for student.
- Click on the Special Paper Version and select Paper, Braille or Large Print.
- Check the box to confirm the student has a 504, IEP, or ADE's written approval.
- Select Create for a student being manually created, or
- Select **SAVE** when a test assignment is being edited for an existing student.

Step 3 – Move Student to Special Paper Version Test Session

- Go to **TESTING**, select **Sessions**.
- To search for the computer-based test session and the SPV test session, click on **Search**, select **Show all results**.
- Place a check mark next to both the computer-based test session and the SPV test session for the correct school.
- Click on the Go to Students in Sessions link.
- Under the Session List, select Combined View.
- Place a check mark next to the student(s) name(s) that will be moved to the SPV test session.
- Go to Start and select All Tasks.
- Select the **Move Students between Sessions** tab. Check the box of the session the student is being moved to (SPV session).
- Select Move. Click Exit Tasks.
- Refer to directions provided in the Spring 2020 AzSCI Prototype Field Test PearsonAccess^{next} User's Guide.

Step 4 – Place an Additional Order for a SPV test

- All steps listed above must be completed prior to submitting an additional order. This includes submitting an SPV test request and receiving approval from ADE, as well as Steps 1 through 3 listed above to assign an SPV test to a student in PAN.

Done	Task 6– Additional Order Window –	Dates
	Special Paper Version Tests, Manuals (optional), & Tracking Materials	
	 Place <u>one</u> consolidated Additional Order for the entire district. All Additional Orders will be approved by ADE. Be prepared to justify additional orders. District Test Coordinator's Manuals (TCMs) and Test Administration Directions (TADs) for all regular online tests are available on the ADE website and will not initially be sent to districts. Paper copies can also be requested through an Additional Order. An Additional Order must be completed for all Special Paper Version Tests and for the return shipment materials. Notes: ADE will review each additional order prior to shipment. There must be an indication in PearsonAccess^{next} for each student that requires a Special Paper Version accommodation (<i>Task 5</i>). Verify within 24 hours after the order is placed that the order is approved by ADE. An email will be sent to the user when the additional order has shipped. 	1/6/20– 02/13/20 Closes at 5 p.m. MST

Ordering Materials in PAN:

- Login to PAN. Under SETUP, select Orders & Shipment Tracking.
- Go to Start, select All Tasks.
- Verify the Organization (Code) is for the correct district.
- In the **Date Needed*** field, enter today's date.
- Verify the **Ship To** information is correct. If there is an error in the address, do not continue with this order. Contact <u>AIMSScience@azed.gov</u> to update the contact information.
- Select Add Items to open the Edit Materials Order screen.
- Enter the quantity of each item needed. Select **Save**.

	 Related activities to prepare a test session include: Seal Codes Scheduled Sessions Session Student Roster Testing Tickets Must be started no earlier than a couple of days before testing. 	Several days prior to testing

To access the following <u>various</u> Resources in PAN:

- Login to PAN. Go to **TESTING**, select **Sessions**.
- At the Search drop-down, check the Show All Results box.
- Check the box(es) to select session(s) you want to work with.
- Select the **Go to Students in Sessions** link.
- Select a session name from the Session List.
- Select the **Resources** drop-down menu to see the list of session resources.

Seal Codes:

- At the **Resources** drop-down, select **Seal Codes**.
- The **Seal Codes** will open in a new tab for the selected session.
- Each session will have a unique Seal Code.

Scheduled Sessions:

- Go back to the **Students in Session** tab.
- At the **Resources** drop-down, select **Scheduled Sessions**.
- The Scheduled Sessions will open in a new tab.

Session Student Roster (a list of all students assigned to a session):

- Go back to the **Students in Session** tab.
- At the Resources drop-down, select Session Student Roster.
- The Session Student Roster will open in a new tab.

Testing Tickets:

- Go back to the **Students in Session** tab.
- At the **Resources** drop-down, select whether to print:
 - For all students in a session, select **Print all for this session**, or
 - Just for select students, select **Print selected for this session.**
- To print testing tickets for select students:
 - Enter information into **Filters** section.
 - Check box(es) for student(s) needing a testing ticket.
- Testing Tickets will open in a new tab.

Done	Task 8 – Preparing a Session in PearsonAccess ^{next}	Dates
	This task should be done prior to the first day of testing and can take time to complete, depending on how many students are in the session.	Several days prior to testing

- Login to PAN. Go to **TESTING**, select **Sessions**.
- At the **Search** drop-down, check the **Show All Results** box.
- Check the box(es) next to the session(s) you want to work with.
- Select the Go to **Students in Sessions** link.
- Select a session name from the Session List, or
- Select the **Combined View** to manage all sessions at the same time.
- Click the **Prepare Session** button.
- The session will show as **Ready** and the green **Start Sess**ion button will appear.

	AzSCI Prototype Field Test Administration Window for students in grades 5, 8, and 11.	1/27/20- 2/21/20
	NOTE: All Student responses from Special Paper Version tests must be entered into the TestNav system within this same window.	

Done	Task 10 – Testing Day Activities	Dates
	A test session must be started and unlocked by Test Administrators for students present for testing.	Day of Testing
	NOTE: This must be completed before students can login to TestNav.	

Starting a Session:

- Login to PAN. Go to **TESTING**, select **Sessions**.
- Check the box(es) next to the session(s) you want to work with.
- Select the **Go to Students in Sessions** link.
- Select the session name from the **Session List**.
- Select the session student is assigned to by either:
 - o Selecting Combined View and entering information into the Filters, or
 - Selecting a session and scrolling through the list of students assigned to each of the sessions.
- Test Administrators may start each session
 - o Individually by clicking on each session in the Session List, or
 - Starting multiple sessions by using the **Combined View** in the **Session List**.
- Click the **Start Session** for individual sessions, or the **Start All Sessions** for the combined view.

Unlocking Student Tests:

- There are two ways to unlock tests for students:
 - For all students in a session, in the top portion of the screen, click and drag the lock/unlock switch for all tests in a session, or
 - For individual students, in the bottom portion of the screen, click the Student Test Status drop-down and select unlock for each student.

Resuming a Student Test in PAN:

- Login to PAN. Under TESTING select Sessions.
- Go to Search, select Show All Results.
- Check box to select session(s). Select **Go to Students in Sessions** link.
- Select a session from the **Session List**.
- Check the student test that is in **Exited** status.
- Go to Start, select All Tasks.
- Under the **Resume Student Tests** tab, check the student that needs to be resumed in the **Students in Sessions**.
- Click Resume.
