

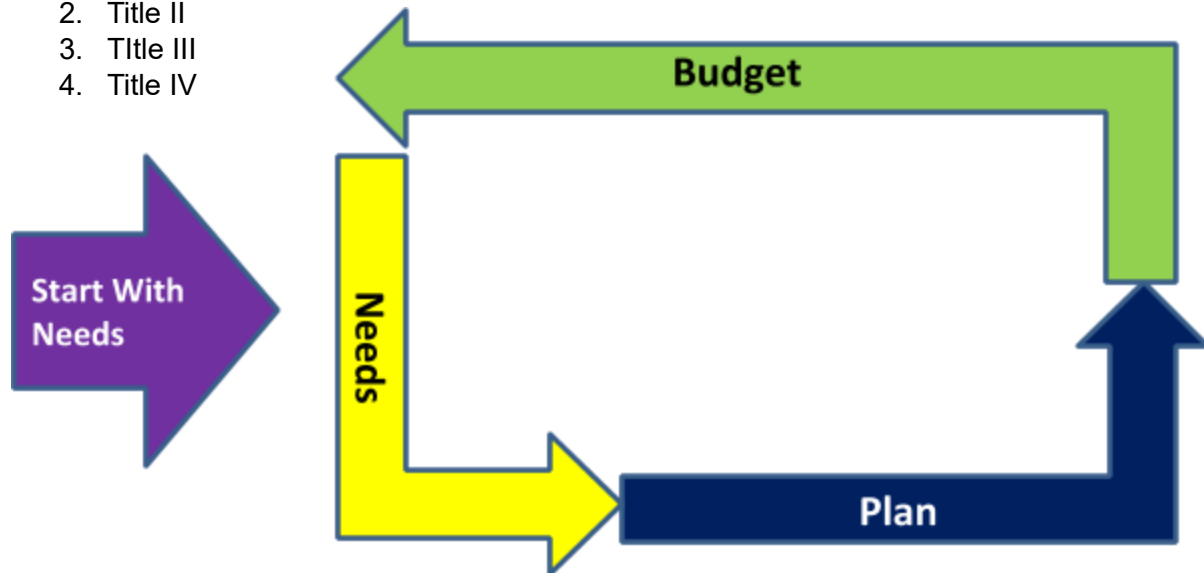
Tags on Action Steps in the Integrated Action Plan (IAP)

FUNDING TAGS

Action Steps in the Integrated Action Plan (IAP) are labeled with Funding Tags to identify funding sources. Funding tags are required to help ensure alignment of the IAP and items in the grant application. The IAP drives the grant application budget.

District Level Programs:

1. Title I Set-Asides
2. Title II
3. Title III
4. Title IV



Fiscal applications focus on accounting expenses to be supported by a given grant, with all expenses aligned to activities that have been tagged as being funded by that grant in the IAP. Grant specific green funding tags are utilized for each action step aligned to a grant budget line item. Multiple tags may be applied to a given activity to fund that activity (subject to the allowability and requirements of each individual grant program). Activities tagged with a Funding Tag should have associated expenses accounted for in the grant application associated with that tag.

PROGRAM TAGS

Program Tags are now to be utilized in conjunction with funding tags where appropriate. Program Tags indicate how activities may impact different programs and/or student populations. They may be associated with funding tags – but are not considered to be associated with a specific funding source.

Title I-A Set Asides will need an additional Program Tag to delineate intent and purpose
