ABE Math Instruction to Help All Learners Succeed

The two-day session for ABE teachers will learn strategies for differentiating math instruction to help students master *The Arizona Adult Education Standards for Mathematics*. Day One will focus on differentiating assignments, instruction, and assessments. Day Two will cover the four representations of algebraic functions connected to real-world situations.

English Language Acquisition Strategies Through Digital Literacy

The two-day session for ELAA teachers will include strategies for incorporating more digital literacy for language learners by learning the *LINCS ESL Pro Module 2 strategies* and implementing the strategies using the *Burlington English* online curriculum. Day One will consist of the theory behind including digital literacy instruction with language learners.
