10 Production records do not accurately reflect recipe numbers. Specifically, during the month of components and ensuring consistency review, banana bread, bagel with light cream cheese, Trix Yoplait yogurt, large banana muffin, cheese quesadilla, baked beef ziti, and turkey sandwich K-8, 6-8.

11 Recipes provided did not contain all required sections: amounts for lettuce on recipe E-35, Turkey Sandwich K-8, 6-8.

Discussed all menu items that contain more than 1 ingredient must have a standardized recipe. Standardized recipes must include the following information: recipe name, recipe number, ingredients and amounts, serving size, recipe yield, preparation instructions, HACCP process, and HACCP instructions. Please provide an updated recipe for Turkey Sandwich K-8, 6-8. Additionally, please provide written assurance that all recipes will be updated with amounts for all ingredients.

12 Meal contribution crediting is not accurate for all Discussed updating recipes to reflect recipes. Specifically, the mozzarella portion of the current products being used. Baked Marinara Beef Ziti K-8 credits as .5oz/eq. m/ma, not .25oz/eq. m/ma as indicated on the recipe.

Please provide an updated recipe for Baked Marinara Beef Ziti K-8. Additionally, please provide written assurance that all recipes will be updated with accurate crediting.

13 Site application in CNPWeb indicated that SFA is operating Breakfast in the Classroom and Grab N Go breakfast carts when the SFA is also serving breakfast in the cafeteria/main dining area.

Discussed steps required to update site practices.

Please resubmit a site application indicating that application in CNPWeb to reflect current breakfast in the cafeteria is also being served. Additionally, p lease provide written assurance that the site application in ADE's CNPWeb will accurately reflect current practices.
