


Title IV-A Grant Application Checklist



Purpose: This checklist serves as a guide to complete the Title IV-A grant application and check for completion in each section. Section title links will bring you to a short video training that will help you complete each section of the Title IV-A grant.




o I have adequately described the LEA Title IV-A program in one to two paragraphs.


Budget


- o I have followed the USFR or USFRCS coding guidelines.
- I have detailed all my budgeted expenditures in the LEA Integrated Action Plan.
- I have labeled each expenditure under one (or more) Title IV-A Category.
- I have verified that the **budget narrative total** and the **line item total** are properly calculated and equal.
- I have ensured that all activities are aligned to the intent of the Title IV-A grant.
- I have fully described the activity by:
 - o Indicating the staff type and number of staff who are participating
 - o Breaking down the cost by cost per unit, cost per hour, number of weeks, etc.
 - Indicating and describing the supplies that are being purchased
 - Describing the scope of work of the activity
- If I have allocated funds to salaries, I have also included benefits under 6200.
- If this expenditure is being funded by additional sources, I have indicated the source in the Budget Narrative and LIAP.
- I have not exceeded the 2% Direct Admin Cost limit or the Indirect Cost limit.
















Title IV-A Special Rules

15% Rule (All LEA's regardless of allocation):

- My technology infrastructure purchase does not exceed 15% of the total amount allocated to the Effective Use of Technology.
 - Method to calculate: (Amount allocated to Effective Use of Technology (PD/stipends/etc.) / .85) x .15
 - Example: (\$15,000 x .85) x .15 = \$2,647.06 Maximum Technology Infrastructure

20/20 Portion Rule (LEA's with an allocation greater than \$30,000):

- o I have allocated at least 20% of my allocation (without carryover) to Well-Rounded Education.
- o have allocated at least 20% of my allocation (without carryover) to Safe and Healthy Students.
- o I have allocated at least 1 line item to the Effective Use of Technology.
- o If I did not meet the previous year's 20/20 Portion Rule, I have met the updated minimum amount, in addition to the minimum 20% for Well-Rounded and Safe and Healthy.

Program Narrative

- o In each category, I have fully described my program (referencing the budgeted items labeled with that category).
- o I have checked the appropriate checkboxes within each category.
- o If I indicated a cross-category expenditure, I have included it in all appropriate sections.



Title IV-A Allocation Worksheet

- In the FY21 Grant Application, the Budget Summary will auto-populate based on your allocations and reflect any transfers and/or carryover.
- o I have completed the appropriate Budget Categories Section.
 - o I have separated my allocation into the appropriate budget categories, as aligned with my budget narratives.
 - o If I have carryover, I have used the Approved Carryover Line
 - o I have appropriately accounted for the previous year and current year 20/20 Portion Rule.



Eligible Private School Service

- o I have engaged in timely and meaningful consultation with my In-District private schools.
- o I have uploaded the completed Affirmation of Consultation to the **Title I Related Documents**.
- I have completed the Title IV-A Eligible Private School Service page and determined the Private School Allocation for all In-District Participating Private Schools.
 - LEAs without In-District Private Schools must still upload an Affirmation of Consultation
- o I have clearly labeled the Private School Allocation in my Budget Narrative with the name of the Private School.
- I have allocated all required funds to the Participating In-District Private Schools.
- o I have included the Private School program in the LIAP.
- o If I am including Administrative Costs to "Provide Private School Services", they are included in my direct/ indirect costs.
 - The Direct Costs do not exceed the 2% cap.
 - The Indirect Costs do not exceed the Indirect Cost Limit.
 - Any Direct/ Indirect Costs are captured in the budget

Assurances

- o I have checked each applicable box to assure that the statement is true.
- I have signed the Assurances Page.
- o If my allocation is greater than \$30,000, I have checked the **Yes to All** box for Question 8.
- o If my allocation is less than \$30,000, I have checked the **Yes to Following** Box, as well as the appropriate category boxes:
 - o If I am running a Well-Rounded Education Program, I have checked box 8A.
 - o If I am running a Safe and Healthy Students Program, I have checked box 8B.
 - o If I am running an Effective Use of Technology Program, I have checked box 8C.
