Specifically, the weekly vegetable quantity of 3 3/4 cups was not offered at lunch during the review period, October 21-25, 2019. Instead, only 3 5/8 cups vegetables was offered. This was not a repeat finding from cycle two therefore did not contribute toward fiscal action calculations.

Quantities observed during the review period did not meet minimum amounts required by the meal pattern. Specifically, the weekly grain quantity of 8 ounce equivalents was not offered at lunch during the review period, October 21-25, recipes, etc.). Meal pattern requirements one week of lunch production records 2019. Instead, only 6.25 ounce equivalents of grains were offered. This was determined to be a repeat finding from cycle two and contributed toward fiscal action calculations.
